

Dress Code for all our students

For Girls: Simple and practical clothing for living in the country, including necessarily:

□ Dresses (with long or short sleeves) or skirts, in the following colors: blue, dark green, gray, brown, beige, discreet plaid, or discreet print for summer, of classical cut, pleated and ample, without slits, mid-calf in length, avoiding denim and jersey

From 8th grade and up, we ask you to choose skirts in the styles to be found on the website of Magellys, under the names: Dominique, Alienor, Anne, Apolline, Caroline, Helene, Marie, Martine, Marianne.

- **White** or **discreetly colored** blouses, pullovers and other sweaters of sober form and colors.
- For reasons of **decency** and **hygiene**, we require a **white, cotton** full slip, or a half slip and undershirt.
- **Flat, classical** school shoes or sandals
- For the chapel: The “Veritas” beret
- For festive occasions: a navy blue skirt (model to be announced), the navy “Rome” sweater (model to be announced)

For Boys: Simple clothing for living in the country (pants, belt, and collared shirt) of discreet colors (cf. colors for girls’ skirts). No shorts or jeans

- **Sturdy, classical** shoes
- For festive occasions: navy pants, a white shirt, navy or red sleeveless vest ([Benito&Benita sweater vest school vest v-neck uniforms cotton cable-knit pull-over for boys/girls](#) available on Amazon) OR (www.cookieskids.com item # LTG03914), oxford shoes and tie (www.cookieskids.com item # SBR01231)

For Girls and Boys:

- **Two long-sleeved navy blue smocks** available at [RMF Scrubs, girls: lab coat; boys: request navy for item #JK281](#) or at www.a2zuniforms.com, girls: Landau 3155 Lab Coat

For physical education:

- A loose-fitting white or navy blue polo shirt
- Tennis shoes or sneakers
- A cloth bag
- Boys: navy shorts (or sweatpants for the winter), socks
- Girls: a white or navy blue skort, ample and to the knee, available at www.academictadcat.com (double-pleated front skort or double button skort) or at <https://www.dressingforhisglory.com/school-uniforms/flare-skort-uniform/girl-flared-skort.html> - socks; white or navy blue tights, if necessary, in winter
- **Coats or jackets** of discreet colors (blue, dark green, brown, grey, beige); no pink, red or purple

The following are strictly forbidden:

- Dresses or skirts that are straight, too long, too short, slit, gypsy style, tiered or ruffled, denim, jersey, flimsy or form-fitting, of colors other than those listed above, especially black
- Pants (for girls), split skirts or culottes, and we ask mothers to give a good example
- T-shirts, sweatshirts, hooded sweaters and sportswear
- All black clothing
- Leggings and indecent, black or colored underclothing
- Clogs, moccasins, ballerina, high-heeled, canvas or odd shoes, tall leather boots
- Make-up, perfume, beauty products, dyed hair, nail polish and jewelry (rings, earrings, necklaces, bracelets...)
- All electronics: walkman, camera, CD player or equivalent, cell phone (except for travel), radio, iPod, etc.

If children have cell phones for traveling, the device should be only for phoning (without music, movies or internet connection) and must be handed to the Sisters as soon as the children arrive at school.

ALL ARTICLES OF CLOTHING MUST BE LABELED WITH THE CHILD’S NAME.

NECESSITIES FOR BOARDING STUDENTS

Linens:

- 2 sets of sheets of a solid color, preferably white
- 4 pillow cases
- 1 twin size waterproof mattress pad (not a plastic sheet)
- 4 small towels different in color, hand-towel size
- 4 washcloths, preferably paired in color with the towels
- 3 cloth table napkins
- 2 napkin pouches

Toiletries:

- 1 toiletry kit, including a plastic cup
- 1 shoe polish kit
- 1 laundry bag
- 4 zippered mesh bags no smaller than 12" x 18"
- 1 shower cap, if desired
- Girls under the age of 8, or under 4'9" or under 100 lbs. must bring a car seat.

Suggested Medicines:

- stomach relief
- cough medicine
- cough drops
- cold medicine
- first aid supplies
- pain reliever
- stationery

Personal Clothing:

(Please respect the dress code indications: everything should be classical in color and style.)

- 1 hooded raincoat
- 1 coat
- 2 long-sleeved blue smocks
- 2 sweaters, including a "Rome sweater"
- 1 pair of tennis shoes
- 1 pair of boots (snow/rain)
- 3 long ample nightgowns with sleeves (no pajamas)
- Socks, preferably cotton (10 pairs *); tights as needed
- Skirts and dresses (4 or 5); one must be navy blue
- White cotton underclothing: 10* pairs of underwear (briefs), 5* undershirts, 3* slips
- For winter: knee socks and/or tights, 2 hats, 2 scarves, 2 pairs of mittens or gloves
- Shirts/blouses (5 or 6); one must be white
- Facial tissues or handkerchiefs (10)
- 1 bathrobe
- 1 pair of slippers
- 2 pairs of school shoes

* for boarders who do not go home every weekend

Please foresee a dressier outfit, compliant still with the dress code, for Sundays and feast days.

For other details, refer to the dress code. Clothing supplies must be sufficient to allow changing and washing. Do not send garments which require dry cleaning.

All belongings must be labeled, and the girls should have labels with them at school. Please use only sew-on labels, since marker washes out and iron-on labels wash off. Parents may call their children on the phone once per weekend, that is, on Friday evening, Saturday, or Sunday, and may speak for 15 or 30 minutes.
