Dear Parents of Assumption Academy,

As you well know, a Catholic School, although a source of innumerable blessings, requires an immense amount of sacrifice as well. Assumption Academy is no different and in order to make the cost of tuition reasonable you agree to raise at least \$400 per student, in one of the various fundraisers throughout the year so as not to be billed the deficit. This letter explains the different qualifications of how participation in these various fundraisers will count towards your fundraising goal.

These are the various Fundraisers and their requirements:

Festival Sponsorship- If a family gets two or more businesses to sponsor Assumption Festival, the total amount of these sponsorships will go to your fundraising obligation.

(Any non-cash sponsorship must be approved by Headmaster to count towards the fundraising goal)

(Sponsorships count towards the fundraising goal of the academic year previous to the festival-a sponsorship for 2020 festival is for 2019-2020 academic year)

Sweepstakes- Sell 40 or more sweepstakes tickets and the total amount raised will count towards your fundraising goal. *(In a sweepstakes participants make a donation so if the donation amount is \$400 even if the amount of tickets is less than 40 the fundraising goal is met.)*

(All tickets sold from March 14th 2020 until the closing of individual ticket sales at 9am on September 16th 2020 will go for the 2019-2020 fundraising goal.)
